Sunday, August 24 Annual Church service and Open House at the WHS's 1845 Lower Warner Meeting House, 232 East Main Street. A Church service with the United Church of Warner will begin at 10:00 am, followed by an Open House until 1:00 pm.

Six planets are lined up in an arc in the night sky to the end of August. Four of these -Mercury, Venus, Jupiter, and Saturn—can be seen with the naked eye, while Uranus and Neptune will be visible through a very strong pair of skywatching binoculars or a backyard telescope. The next time that all of these planets will be visible together won't be until February 2026. The best date to view these planets is on the nights leading up to August 23, when there will be little to no moonlight and when Mercury will be at its furthest point from the sun. Borrow the library's Telescope for an even better view! Have a party!
