





AI-free search engine— <https://noai.duckduckgo.com>

Google has free SAT practice exams in Gemini, plus a writing coach: free, full-length SAT practice exams are coming to Gemini, thanks to a partnership with The Princeton Review. To get started, just say "I want to take a practice SAT test" in Gemini. Google is also partnering with **Khan Academy** to launch **Writing Coach**, an AI tutor that helps students improve their writing through interactive feedback. Both tools are available now for free.

Fun fact: Our online language program **Transparent Language Online** has both an English and a Spanish version of the [2025 Citizenship practice tests](#). It is a tutorial format with realistic Q&A. Try it for fun and see if you would pass! Free to use with your library card. Ask staff how to access this resource which has over 100 languages to learn.

Tech Tips: Audio books etc

If you are using the **free downloadable audio books** from [OverDrive/Libby](#), be aware that you can change the **default loan time from 7 days to 14 days** in your account settings. You must change it BEFORE you hit borrow.

If you have to renew a title, this will usually use up one of the purchased total "lease" uses so please don't borrow more than you can read in the 2 weeks - **use "suspend hold"** if a hold becomes available before you are ready, then unsuspend it when you are almost ready, and you will be next. Thanks for helping to keep costs down!

Good News: We have started purchasing downloadable titles / title leases JUST FOR WARNER for popular titles with large numbers of holds, so our borrowers can get access faster. This is accessed with the same search. Feel free to point out titles in demand.

iPhone 17 and newer models can use the built-in Camera app's Dual Capture feature to **record videos using both front and back cameras** simultaneously. This allows users to capture their reactions while recording something special. [iPhoneLife.com Article](#)


